
difference.






Over the past three years, Offrejoie has completed the renovation of 1,400 **residential apartments** and 39 shops in 157 buildings located in the neighborhoods of Karantina, Rmeil, Mar Mikhael and home to 5,000 people. In addition to the internal rehabilitation of the apartments, works included the full renovation of the external façades of all 157 buildings, in addition to internal works in common areas such as rewiring of electrical connections, water pipes, repairs to the staircases, roof and replacement of water tanks. **(photos on page 6)**



In addition, working closely with the Directorate General of Antiquities (DGA) and **heritage building** experts, Offrejoie completed the restoration of 12 of the most rich heritage buildings in the targeted neighborhoods. Offrejoie has maintained the highest standards during the restoration works with the aim of preserving Beirut's cultural heritage. **(photos on page 7)**



Public spaces play a crucial role in the recovery of the targeted neighborhoods, Offrejoie has therefore prioritized, working jointly with the municipality of Beirut, the restoration of a public garden in Karantina, the rehabilitation of sidewalks and the installation of solar street lighting in both Mar Mikhael and Karantina. Over 5,000 people residing in the targeted neighborhoods have benefited from improved public infrastructure. **(photos on page 9)**

Offrejoie has also supported the community in the restoration of a church and a mosque in Karantina and distributed through partners over 35 containers of in-kind assistance (medical equipment, medicine, cloths, food, school stationary, etc.) received in the aftermath of the port blast. The distributions were completed in partnership with 15 non-governmental organizations, 5 hospitals and 12 public schools.







Donations and Expenditures

Offrejoie would not have been able to respond to the scale it has, following the blast, if it weren't for the generous support of our private individual donors and corporations in Lebanon and abroad. In addition, even amid the worst economic crisis, the Lebanese private sector offered invaluable in-kind support such as construction material and technical expertise. Offrejoie optimized costs by leveraging the skills and engagement of the residents of the neighborhoods, the pro-bono expertise of local companies, and above all its network of local and international volunteers to reduce the cost of manpower where possible.

Beirut Community Center Opening 2023

Offrejoie is launching in the second half of 2023 its Community Center in Beirut. The aim of the center is to provide protection and support for the most vulnerable individuals in the community, enabling them access to essential services and fostering their overall well-being. The establishment of a community center is an effort to address a social protection gap left by the dwindling public services particularly towards women, persons with disability, the elderly and the homeless in Beirut.

Three key activities that will be initiated in the Community Center before the end of 2023:

- provide a safe and welcoming space (this includes use of shower facilities and public areas of the \bullet center) and offer hot and nutritious meals to those in need on a regular basis.
- organize learning and recreational activities for children using the designated child-friendly space \bullet within the community center, offering them a safe and enjoyable environment.
- provide social engagement activities, companionship, and assistance tailored to the unique needs \bullet of the elderly, ensuring their well-being and inclusion within the community.

Through the Community Center, Offrejoie aims to support at least 3,000 unique beneficiaries on a yearly basis.

Sustainability: Offrejoie will work on the development of a long-term sustainability plan, exploring income-generating activities, establishing partnerships with local businesses, and seeking opportunities for social enterprise initiatives with the objective of diversifying the sources of funding complementing donor grant funding on the mid-long term. In addition to the financial sustainability of the center, other aspects such as environmental sustainability will be adopted in the management of the community center (on solid waste management, water and other natural resources management, reliance on renewable energy).

Accountability: In its management of the community center, Offrejoie will prioritize accountability to its beneficiaries by implementing a feedback collection and response mechanism. It encourages open communication through suggestion boxes, feedback forms, and community meetings.
